

NORTH CARRETERA AUSTRAL – NATURE THAT INSPIRES EXPOLAGOS 2025 - Pre Program

August 28 (Thrusday)

- ✓ Reception at the airport of Balmaceda and transfer to your hotel in Coyhaique.
 - Optional service.

August 29 (Friday) (BoxL, D)

- Around 9a.m. departure from your hotel in Coyhaique and drive northbound along the Carretera Austral, admiring its wonderful landscape, its lush vegetation, and passing through the town of Puyuhuapi up to La Junta town. The stretch between the city of Coyhaique and Puerto Aysen, which you will drive through is one of the most scenic routes in Chile, including the Río Simpson National Reserve that we will visit during the journey. You will also visit the picturesque town of Puyuhuapi, on the shores of the fjord of the same name.
- ✓ Box lunch.
- ✓ Some kilometers before arriving at the town of La Junta, we will visit the Patagonian Tepaluma gin distillery, which is located on a farm in an environment of forests, rivers and waterfalls. During the visit, we will discover why it won a gold medal in an international competition.
- ✓ Dinner and accommodation in Espacio y Tiempo Hotel or similar.

August 30 (Saturday) (B, D)

- ✓ Today's morning half-day trek to Lake Rosselot National Reserve will give you the chance to admire the lush flora and enjoy panoramic views of the valley and its rivers, weather permitting.
 - Medium difficulty 5km approximately 2,30hrs.
- ✓ Once back to La Junta, explore its town visiting its Main Square, its Handicraft Market and its just renovated charming Catholic church.
- ✓ Free time to have lunch on your own at a local restaurant.
- ✓ This afternoon, departure to Rosselot River (just 1km away) to relaxedly float down the river on a raft, from where you can observe the confluence of the Palena River, one of the 3 most important tributaries of the Aysén region. Within the 16km route, you will see beautiful landscapes provided by nature and a varied fauna of Patagonia, accompanied by countless species of birds who will guide the route with their songs. After sailing for around 2 ½ hours, disembark at the destination beach to travel 6km by vehicle to the El Sauce Natural Hot Springs. In these hot springs, thermal baths are offered in the pools with warm 100% natural waters, being able to acquire the great benefits that these waters provide, in addition to being able to relax and contemplate the impressive vistas around you.
- ✓ Drive back to the hotel. Dinner and accommodation.

*** *** If weather conditions do not allow us to sail down the river, we will replace this activity with a visit to Raúl Marín Balmaceda village to explore its wonderful forest and stunning nature.





August 31 (Sunday) (B, BoxL)

✓ Our last day along the legendary Carretera Austral will take us to the famous Queulat National Park to walk a low difficulty trail and enjoy the view of its incredible Hanging Glacier.

Queulat, "Sound of Waterfalls" in the language of the Chonos, was sighted for the first time at the end of the 18th century by the Jesuits who were looking for the entrance to the mythical City of the Caesars. Today the beauty of the Queulat National Park is admired by thousands of visitors who come attracted by its evergreen forests, waterfalls, fjords, steep walls, mighty rivers and its famous hanging snowdrift.

- ✓ Box lunch.
- ✓ Continue all the way to Coyhaigue while enjoying ever-changing scenic views.
- ✓ Drop-off at your hotel in Coyhaigue.
